**Abolishing Standardized Testing Requirements**

AN ACT

An act providing that all Pennsylvania elementary and secondary public schools will no longer be required to complete standardized testing requirements.

Section 1. This act shall be known as the Curriculum in the Classroom Act.

Section 2. Beginning January 1, 2022, no Pennsylvania elementary or secondary public school will be required to comply with standardized testing requirements, which include PSSAs and Keystone Exams. An elementary or secondary public school is directed to use curriculum and academic work standards for each grade level to help measure learning gained each school year.

Section 3. Effective Date: This act shall take effect on August 1, 2022.
